There are two parts to the new Stallion Incentive Fund Program:

Part 1:

Stallion Incentive Fund classes will be offered after July 1, 2008 for shows requesting to host the SIF classes. The SIF classes will consist of

- 2 year old Western Pleasure - \$1000 added
- 3 year old Hunter Under Saddle - \$1000 added
- 3 year old Non-Pro Western Pleasure - \$500 added

To be eligible to compete in the SIF classes all horses must show an Incentive Fund License. The License may be purchased on line at www.nsba.com or through the NSBA office. Only licensed horses, sired by a sold stallion in the competition year are eligible.

Part 2:

Incentive Fund Licensed horses will also be eligible to earn NSBA Incentive Fund points at Dual Approved shows earning cash value. Payout for Dual Approved points will be based on the purse of the sold stallions for the current year less payouts for SIF classes. The stallion nominator will receive 10% of earnings of offspring in the Dual Approved payout. The foal nominator will receive 10% of earnings of foal in Dual Approved payout. The foal nominator will receive 10% and the owner will receive 80% of the earnings of the foal in the Dual Approved payout.

Incentive Fund License Fee:

- Foals before 12/15 of weanling year - \$100
- Foals after 12/15 of weanling year until 12/31 of yearling year - \$200*

**Horses foaled in 2008 and after must be licensed by 12/31 of the yearling year to be eligible for participation in Stallion Incentive Fund programs*

- Horses foaled between 1985-2007 - \$200 (until 2011)
