EWD/HOH

- Funding for Congress 2021 is in place. The Foundation needs to secure funding for 2022.
- HOH East/West Event at WEC/Ocala in March was a successful introduction to the hunter equestrians. In order to run this program, \$25,000 is needed and a program manager would be beneficial as well. These funds are currently not in place.
- 90 Riders/90 days The Foundation has 86 donors to date with many being new donors in the program. We will reach the 2021 goal. The Foundation discussed changing the name from I Sponsored a Rider to I Sponsored a Rider Program.

• Laurel Champlin gave an update and reviewed the criteria for applicants.

Education

- Youth of the Year The Susan Scott Memorial Scholarship will reside under this program with the restricted funds received from the saddle auction and other donations. The dead-line for youth to apply for the award is June 1.
- Scholarships are being reviewed and will be announced June 1. There was discussion about reviewing the written forms that are online for the applicants.
- Coaches Summit Ryan Cottingim updated the board on the event in Tennessee that had 20 participants. He noted that follow up and networking with the participants will be an important element to keeping them engaged and moving towards competition in NSBA. It was also noted that a program manager would be beneficial to run this program
- Tomorrows Horseman Elise Sheard gave an update on the progress of the program. Graduation will be December 2021. The Foundation does need to secure funds for future classes at \$150,000/2 year class.
