- Shannon Curl Tomorrows Horsemen

 - o Prompted to apply by customer and NSBA Past President, Bill Cosentino

 - Retired from Marion Cty Fire, stands stallion, went to NSBA World Championship Show annually and loved the EWD classes, was asked to help run a horse show, and to add EWD classes, led her to apply to Coaches Summit, which inspire her to go to Therapeutic centers, discovered they wanted to show, and now adding classes locally and show opportunities

EDUCATION

- Raising the Future Education Program; first pitched in 2019 to an ApHC member, Lynn in continued talks with potential funders, opportunity to match, ideally looking to fund a ten year program for \$1 Million dollars
- Veteran Boot; camp USU held back on 2021 VA funding during covid to do large scale boot camp. Funds no longer available. Outreach to land grant university, looking to work together to quantify the results, NSBA seeking to grow the competition among the Veteran riders.

Karl Hoopes indicated USU hesitant to approve studies, able to do clinical research review because of relation with VA and IRB, institutional review board. Veterans want competition, are mission driven, end goals are important.
