**PLEASE READ** the following rules that pertain to NSBA Non-Pro/Amateur eligibility. These rules are to ensure the status of the rider. Owners and riders in non-pro/amateur events must be NSBA members in good standing. An official NSBA Non-Pro/Amateur card must be presented to show committees for verification of a rider's non-pro/amateur status with NSBA.

### Eligibility

The exhibitor may be a youth 18 years of age or younger or an Amateur as defined by an NSBA recognized association or national governing body holding a current and valid amateur card or an amateur that has completed and submitted this NSBA Non Pro Application form.

For purposes of non pro/amateur ownership rules, refer to the official NSBA Handbook per division.

Leased horses are eligible to show in NSBA non-pro/amateur, open and youth/junior events. See specific lease rules per division in the NSBA Rulebook.

If horse ownership is under a separate legal entity, such as family corporation, trust or partnership, farm or ranch, please provide the entity name and all legal and equitable owners and beneficiaries of the legal entity below. Corporation or LLC of which the non-pro/amateur or immediate family member is a majority "owner" is eligible to be shown by a non-pro/amateur except where otherwise defined.
